Nominations for Youth Academic All-American and Youth Distinguished Academic All-American should be submitted according to the following criteria:

- 1. Nomination form must be submitted directly to the National Horse Judging Team Coaches' Association Academic All-American Chair Sarah Schobert (sschobert@tamu.edu). The form must be filled out completely and be accompanied by recommendation and official honorary commitment from their coach that their GPA qualifies. (In addition, the Distinguished nominees must include 1, 3 x 5 pictures (DIGITAL PREFERRED). COACH must complete "Submitted by" information to confirm student eligibility.
- 2. Student must have participated in at least two seasons at the youth level (club, association, chapter or school) from which he/she is nominated.
- 3. Academic All-American nominee must have a cumulative GPA of 3.50 to 3.79 on a 4.0 scale Distinguished Academic All-American nominee must have a cumulative GPA of 3.80 or better on a 4.0 scale.
- 4. <u>Must have placed in the top ten overall in at least one of the following contests</u>: Summer APHA World Show Contest, Fall APHA World Show Contest, All American Quarter Horse Congress, Arabian Nationals, AQHA World Show, Pinto World Show, ABRA World Show, NRHA, NCHA, NRCHA, National FFA & National 4H (Denver or Louisville) <u>In addition, judgers must compete in at least three of</u> <u>these contests representing the club, chapter, school from which he/she is nominated.</u>

PROCEDURES TO BE UTILIZED IN DETERMINING THE RECIPIENTS:

- 1. Nominations must be mailed to the NHJTCA All American Chair, post-marked by <u>February 15, 2024,</u> for submissions of the 2023 year.
- 2. All nominees meeting the minimum requirements will be named Youth Academic All-American and/or Distinguished Academic All-American.
- 3. A list of Youth Academic All-Americans will be released to each coach with certificates for the award winners.
- 4. Nominations will not be accepted without current transcripts and two 3 x 5 pictures if applicable. Unofficial transcripts will suffice.
